You have been charged with a violation of the Seattle Municipal Code or Revised Code of Washington. The charge involved a criminal offense. A conviction can result in a fine or in jail time (up to \$5,000 and/or 365 days for a gross misdemeanor). The alleged offense(s) requires that you appear in court to answer to the charge(s).

INSTRUCTIONS TO DEFENDANT

You are hereby ordered to appear in court at the location, date and time stated above. Failure to appear at the time and place specified may result in a warrant for you arrest, the suspension of your driving privileges or other sanctions allowed by law.

You are presumed innocent until you either are convicted or plead guilty to the charge(s). You have a right to a jury trial. At the hearing specified above, you may be able to discuss your case with a public defender to determine how you wish to respond to the alleged offense(s).

Right to Attorney: You have a right to have an attorney for this and other hearings. If you can not afford to hire your own attorney, you may be eligible for a public defender. However, in accordance with RCW 10.101.020, you must be interviewed to determine whether you qualify financially for a public defender and whether you can contribute to the cost of a public defender. To assist the court in making this determination, please bring with you recent income tax returns, recent pay check stubs, or proof of public assistance, poverty-related veteran's benefits, food stamps or unemployment compensation.

Do not assume that you automatically qualify for, or already have, a public defender. You must be interviewed by court's Defense Screening Services.

To obtain an appointed attorney, promptly go to Seattle Municipal Court for a personal interview: Defense Screening Services; Seattle Justice Center – 2nd Floor Room 235 – Court Resource Center; 600 Fifth Avenue; Seattle WA 09104-4987. The office is open Mon to Fri except holidays between 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM.

It is important that you obtain an attorney immediately. This will allow the attorney sufficient time to prepare your case and may result in fewer or unnecessary, court appearances for you.
